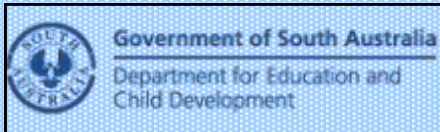

Have a safe and happy holiday.

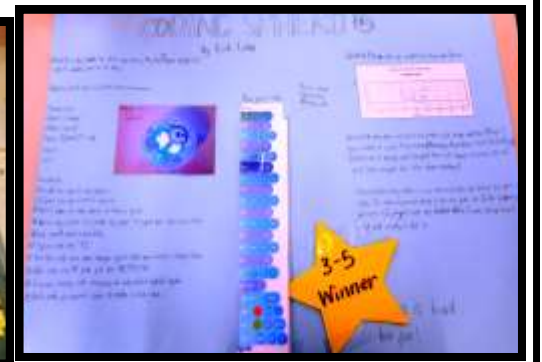
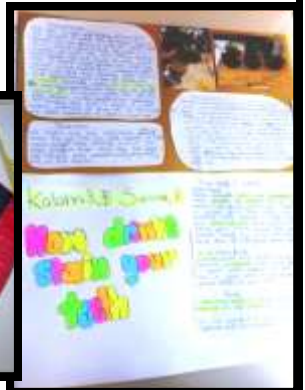
