

Swimming Reminder

Swimming for Reception-Year 2 students runs from Monday 30th October until Friday 3rd November at the Noarlunga Leisure Centre.



Classes are 45 minute sessions and students will travel to and from the centre by chartered bus.

Children should wear their bathers under their school uniform to school. Please provide a bag to take with a towel, change of clothes including underwear (labelled), and a plastic bag for wet items. All medication including named puffers are to be with your child at the swimming centre. If they do not have their medication with them they will not be allowed in the water.

Noarlunga Leisure Centre recommend goggles be worn when swimming in a chlorinated pool to minimise eye irritation.

Payment, consent forms and medical forms need to be returned by Friday 20th October. Please contact Deb (Finance Officer) to make payment arrangements. Please note: Students who have not paid or organised payment by instalment with the Finance Officer by 20th October will not be able to attend.



Year 6/7 Aquatics - Tuesday 21st November to Friday 24th November.

Students should wear bathers under uniforms bring towel, medications and change of clothes.

Sneakers may be required for some activities. Please bring warm clothes for cooler weather, T-shirt, school hat, sunscreen and sunglasses. A pair of bike shorts also minimises irritation when wearing wetsuits.

Named medications & puffers need to be stored in a waterproof bag. Payment, consent & medical forms need to be received by Friday 20th October.
