Principal's Ponderings

Monday saw a start to a school term that I had not experienced in my many years as an educator. It did feel a little weird but it is pleasing to say that in general things went very smoothly. A huge thanks to the teachers, support staff, parents/carers and students for making this happen.

On Tuesday I sent a letter home to parents/carers outlining a few matters including whether parents/carers are going to continue with their child(ren) learning at home, taking into account the much changed circumstances concerning Covid-19 in South Australia. Your response has been swift with at least 81% (up from 51%) of students being at school next Monday.

This very high percentage means that the school will reconsider what learning at home may look like from Monday 4th May, as teachers will now return to their original classes and teaching spaces from that date. Further information will be outlined in due course.
