THE UNIFORM

Parent/carers are encouraged to purchase their child's uniform from the school to ensure the aims of the school dress code are realised. The school's goal is to supply good quality clothing at a competitive price.

Girl's Summer

Navy blue school polo shirt with logo
Navy blue skort or shorts
Blue/white checked dress
Navy blue jumper (windcheater or rugby style)
Navy blue broad brimmed hat (compulsory)

Note: Navy blue graduation hoodie and/or polo shirt (Year 6 only) can be worn all year

Girl's Winter

Navy blue school polo shirt with logo
Navy blue skort or shorts

Note: Navy blue leggings or tights are permitted but are not stocked by the school

Boy's Summer

Hats

Students are required to wear a navy blue broad brimmed hat whilst on school grounds or when representing the school. The hat is optional between May 1st and 31st August, unless otherwise directed by the school.

Footwear

Shoes worn to school need to be appropriate for the range of activities students undertake while at school. Sports shoes, black enclosed shoes or sandals with toe protection are considered appropriate. Footwear that is not appropriate are;

- Thongs and slip-ons
- Shoes with lights or wheels
- Gumboots

Jewellery

Students may wear sleepers or studs with one piercing per ear lobe. A medic alert bracelet is permitted, while items of religious significance are to be discussed with the principal. For safety reasons no rings, necklaces or bracelets (ankle or wrist) permitted.

Hair

Students are expected to have neatly groomed hair, with long hair pulled off the face using plain white, navy or black ties, clips, combs or bands. Large hair accessories are not permitted (e.g. JoJo bows). Parents are encouraged not to permit their child to have dramatic hair colouring or styles as it does bring, unnecessary and at times unwanted attention to the student.

Other considerations:

- Bike pants (blue or black) can be worn under skirts or dresses but **are not** to be visible below the hem line
- Track pants must be navy blue and **are not** to be worn under dresses or skirts
- Denim jeans, shorts or jackets **are not** permitted
- Make-up, acrylic nails and nail polish **are not** permitted
- Brand names or slogans **are not** permitted on clothing (eg: Adidas, Adelaide Crows)
