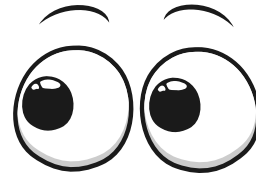

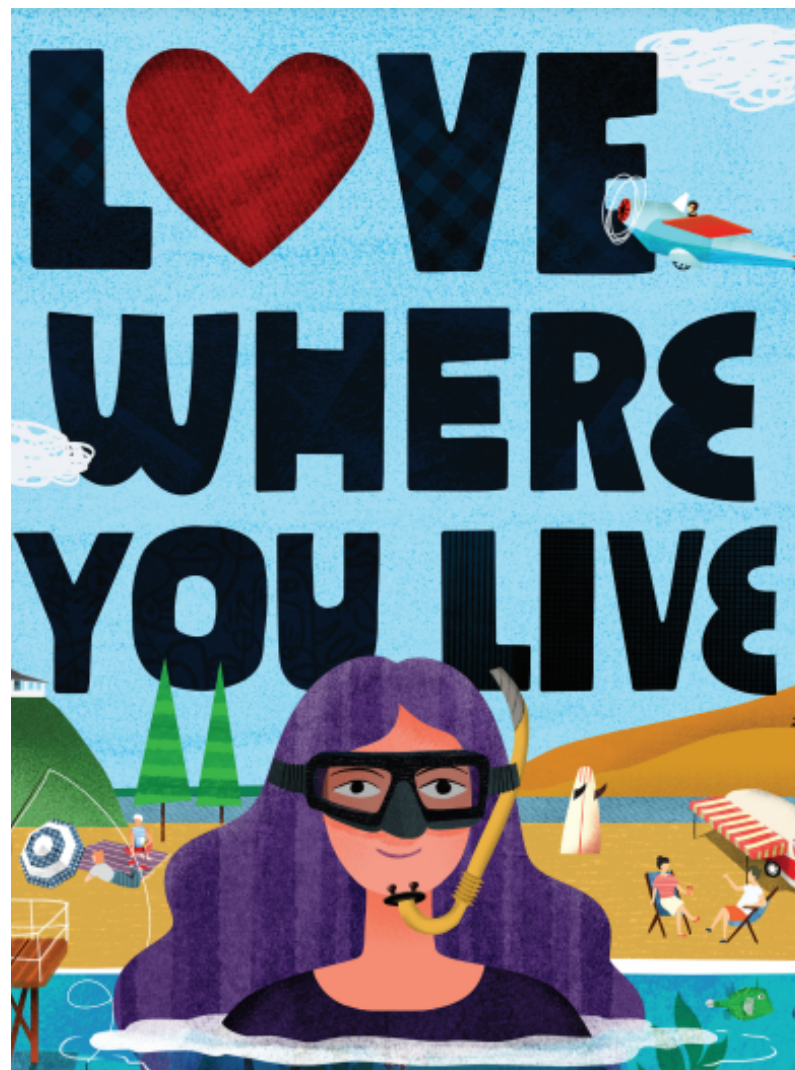
R- 2 SWIMMING
